



2012 CTSH Training prices

The Centre for Training in Social Housing (CTSH) has revised its pricing structure for the delivery of Certificate IV in Social Housing and Diploma in Social Housing. This new pricing structure will be implemented for all training services delivered from 1st January 2012 onwards.

Certificate IV in Social Housing

- Students are required to complete 15 units of study from the Cert IV program to receive the qualification;
- The recommended timeframe for students to complete the qualification is between 1 and 1½ years from the day of their enrolment;
- Each unit of study will cost \$330 for Non-Members. This pricing applies to all modes of delivery: Face to face, E-Learning, Online RCC/RPL and Distance;
- There are 2 extended units within the Cert IV program that needs to be delivered over a longer period of time and attracts a higher cost of \$550 per unit per student;
- The CTSH has designed a suite of Training Packages that combines related units of study. This allows students to complete multiple units of study at the same time and streamlines the amount of time each student needs to invest into attending classes and completing their assessments. Each Training Package costs \$550 per student;

Diploma in Social Housing

- Students are required to complete 18 units of study from the Cert IV program to receive the qualification;
- The recommended timeframe for students to complete the qualification is between 1½ and 2 years from the day of their enrolment;
- Each unit of study will cost \$385 for Non-Members. This pricing applies to all modes of delivery: Face to face, E-Learning, Online RCC/RPL and Distance;
- There are 7 extended units within the Diploma program that needs to be delivered over a longer period of time and attracts a higher cost of \$610 per unit per student;
