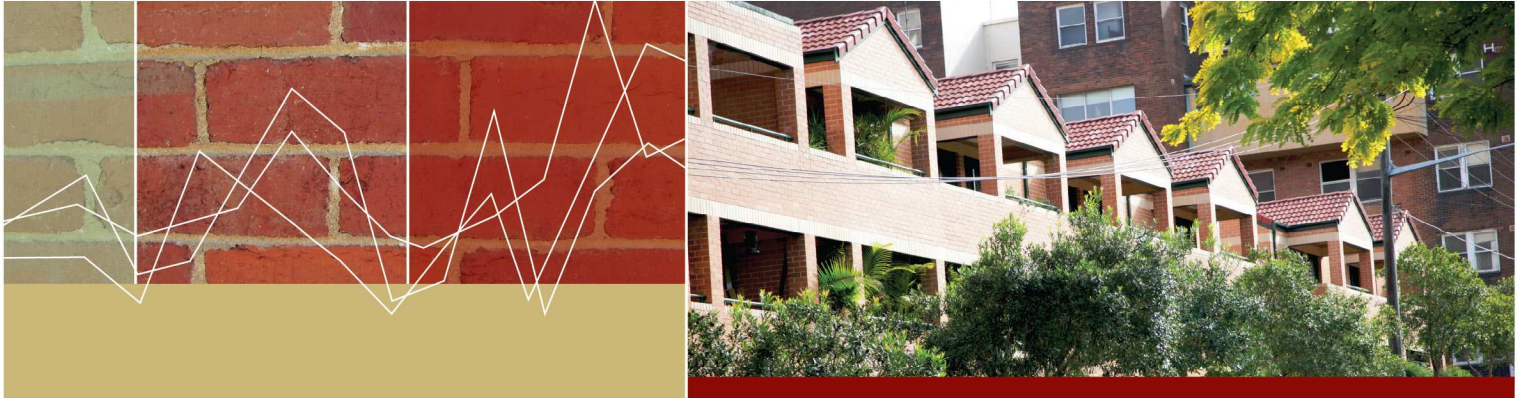

Discussion Paper

The Regulation and Growth of the Not-For-Profit Housing Sector [Discussion Paper](#) was released by the Hon. Tanya Plibersek MP, the Federal Minister for Housing on 22 April 2010. This paper seeks to promote public discussion of a national regulatory system for the not-for-profit housing sector in Australia and suggest ways forward. We are seeking input from the not-for-profit housing sector, investors, tenant groups, Indigenous community housing, developers and the business community into the formulation of clear policy direction to better support and sustain the future growth of the sector.

Key messages include

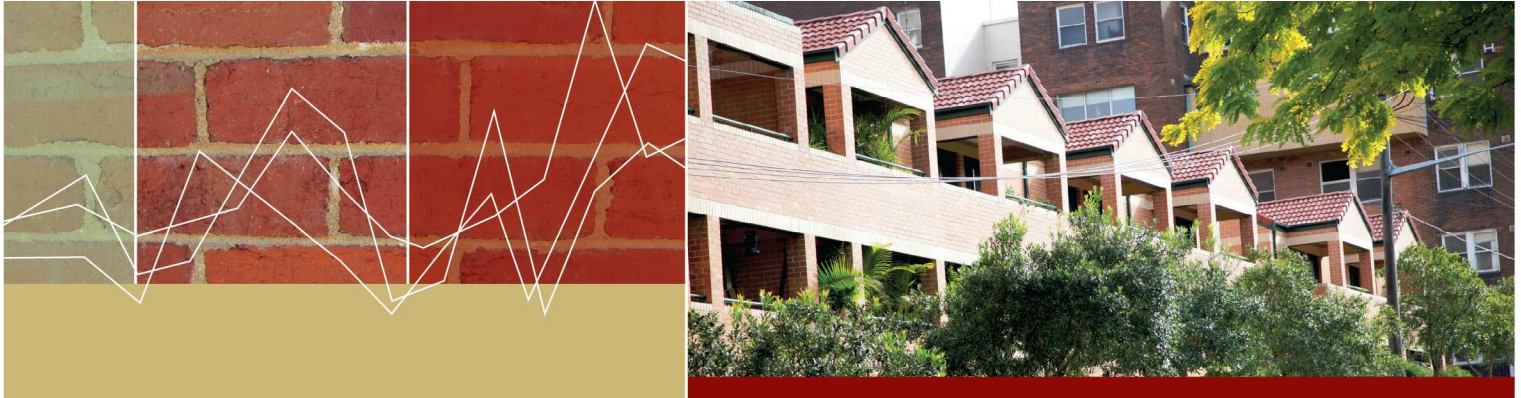
- how the shortage of housing could be addressed through growth in the not-for-profit housing sector
